

#### Housing programs

Since the 1970's housing associations programs, along with public housing, were fundamental in promoting affordable housing

Since 2000 public housing is promoted in rehousing programs (social housing)

Housing associations were relevant until 2009/2011

#### Main policy goals:

Rehousing programs (municipality)

Affordable housing programs in derelict public property (municipality and other actors)

Promote inclusive planning (under the new law)

Incentives to promotion or renting of empty and secondary houses.
